## A message from All-Options' Executive Director, J. Parker Dockray, MSW:

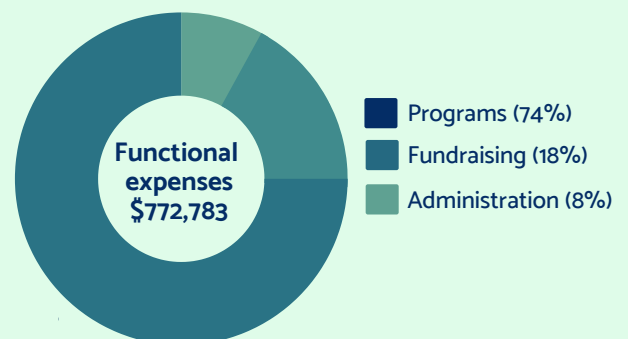
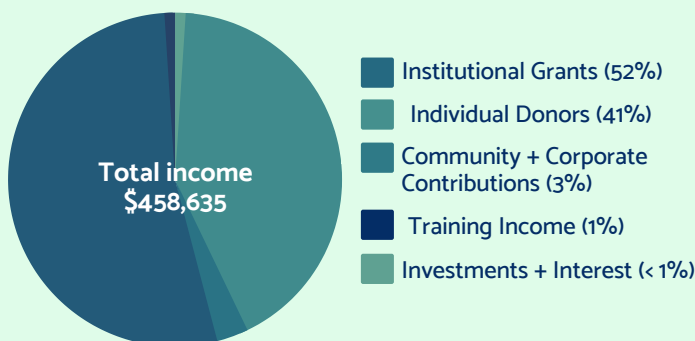

## FINANCIAL HIGHLIGHTS

Although the 2019-2020 fiscal year ended in the midst of a global pandemic and an economic downturn, All-Options remains in a healthy financial position, thanks to a surplus from the previous year and the ongoing generosity of our community. We began the year with \$919,279 in assets and ended with \$703,835, which will help carry us through the uncertainty ahead.



## OUR PROGRAMS

Our All-Options Talkline answered 1,613 calls – a 51% increase over the previous year! – and provided more than 770 hours of support to callers.

Our Hoosier Abortion Fund pledged \$105,064 to help 414 people in Indiana access the abortion care they needed.

Our Hoosier Diaper Program provided 83,284 diapers – plus wipes, condoms, menstrual products, and more – to 172 Bloomington area families.

Our Faith Aloud clergy line supported 66 callers, trained 5 new clergy counselors, and added new videos and resources to our rebranded website.
